GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the spine of the book. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new "AAA" (UM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE


- Install batteries correctly observing the polarity (+, -) signs to avoid leakage.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not use batteries of different types.
- Remove batteries from the equipment when the unit will not be used for an extended period of time.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not attempt to recharge ordinary batteries.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Only batteries of the same and equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickelcadmium) batteries.

PRODUCT FEATURES

VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

Locate the VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH at the back of the book. To adjust the volume, switch to the LOW VOLUME (\triangleleft) or the HIGH VOLUME (() position.



AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Slide 'n Learn Storybook** will automatically power-down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The book can be turned on again by turning the pages or pressing any button.

ACTIVITIES

 Press the Winnie the Pooh Button when the book is either open or closed to hear a sung song or some fun phrases. The Light-up Hive will flash along with the sounds.

 Open the book and turn the pages to hear related fun phrases and sound effects. Slide or twist the moving parts to hear related phrases, sound effects or melodies depending on the page. The Light-up Hive will flash along with the sounds.
