**Counting Fun Elephant – Ages 9 to 24 months – SRP: \$24.99**

VTech's Counting Fun Elephant combines learning with fun as your child distributes colorful balls through an air popper. It is up to a little birdie perched in a nearby nest to decide which path the balls can take, either through the fountain or over the piano keys. While the toy teaches numbers and counting, the elephant's cap lights up and the piano plays music that keeps your child engaged for endless playtime.



**Submarine Learning Boat– Ages 9 to 24 months – SRP: \$17.99**

The Submarine Learning Boat's dolphin captain teaches children about colors, numbers, animals, animal sounds and animal characteristics. The dolphin also likes to play a fun game of hide and seek, asking toddlers to help find some of his animal friends. With each press of a button, infants are rewarded with a squirt of water from the submarine's spout that has two different intensities of squirting to add to the surprise and fun of this learning bath toy. The Boat is also equipped with a water sensor, this little submarine knows when it is diving into the water for some wet and wild fun or if it has reached dry land for a little quieter play time.



**3-in-1 Learning Zebra Scooter– Ages 18 to 36 months – SRP: \$44.99**
