

The recommended rider age of 4-6 years for the drift stage is a suggestion. Any rider unable to comfortably fit on the 4-in-1 Stroll & Grow Tek Trike™ in drift stage should not attempt to ride it. Parents should make the decision to allow their child to ride based on the child's skill level and abilities.



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
2. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
3. Install 2 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.




BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.


1. Align the front wheel (I) with the slot on the frame (A). The pedal lock should be on the right side of the trike tire.
2. Place the covers (T8) over both sides of the frame (A) and screw them together with 4 T7 screws. Then, set aside.




3. Push down the back wheel cover (M) into the slot (L), until it snaps in. Do this twice, once for each wheel.
4. Push the right wheel (L1) and left wheel (L2) into the slots of (C). They will lock in. (The right wheel (L1) has a parking brake but the left wheel does not.)




5. Push the storage bin (F) into the frame (C) until it's secure.




6. Then, screw them together, using 2 T7 screws. Then, set it aside.




7. Align the opening of (D) with frame (B) and place (D) into Stage 1 of frame (B).




8. Put the nuts (with T10) in place and then screw the T2 screws into the nuts.




9. Install the seat belt (P1) for seat (N).






11. Then, screw them together using 4 T7 screws.






16. Press the push button inward as you push the removable seat back (E) into the seat (N).




17. Install the seat belts (P2) for the removable seat back.




18. Use a screwdriver to push the grey pole inside (G) so that the push bead will glide through the white tube to align with the 3 holes.




19. Align the handle (J) with the bar (G). Use T10 to fasten with 2 T4 screws and nuts.




20. Push the push handle (G) down into the hole of frame (C).




21. Fasten the push handle (G) and frame (C) together by inserting (T1).




22. To add the footrest to the trike, first, make sure the front steering lock is in the unlock position and turn the handle bars to the trike's left side.




23. Then, put the footrest (**K**) on top of the trike frame. Ensure the footrest fits snug under the ridges on the trike frame.




24. Next, turn the handlebars so they are facing forward. Then, fasten with 2 T7 screws.



25. Use the push button to insert the canopy (**H**) into the removable seat back (**E**).



26. Insert the wraparound safety bar (**O**) by snapping it to the front of the trike under the interactive panel and into the grooves on the seat (**N**).






27. To adjust the electronics from In-Store Demo Mode to Normal Mode, please press the **ON/OFF BUTTON** and turn the handlebars towards the right, then the **4-in-1 Stroll & Grow Tek Trike™** is ready to be played.


1. ON/OFF BUTTON

To turn the unit **ON**, press the **ON/OFF BUTTON**. Press the **ON/OFF BUTTON** again to turn the unit **OFF**.



2. MODE SELECTOR

Slide the **MODE SELECTOR** to select a mode. In different modes, the response of Role-Play Buttons and Location Buttons will be different.



3. HORN BUTTON

Press the **HORN BUTTON** to see it light up and hear fun sound effects.



4. GEAR SHIFT

Move the **GEAR SHIFT** up or down to hear fun sound effects.



5. IGNITION SWITCH

Turn the **IGNITION SWITCH** to hear a fun sound effect.




11. MUSIC STOP BUTTON

Press the **MUSIC STOP BUTTON** to stop playing sing-along songs or melodies.



12. PEDALING

When there is a melody playing while pedaling in mode 2, 3 or 4, the melody will play faster or slower depending on the speed that you're pedaling.




13. HANDLEBARS

Turn the handlebars left or right, and the trike will call out which way you're turning or play a fun sound effect. In addition, the corresponding light will flash and it will play a sound effect.



14. PEDAL LOCK

When the **PEDAL LOCK** is in the unlocked position the pedals will not control the movement of the front wheel. When the **PEDAL LOCK** is in the locked position the pedals will control the movement of the front wheel.



6. FOUR ROLE-PLAY BUTTONS

Press the **ROLE-PLAY BUTTONS** to hear different phrases from each character.



7. LOCATION BUTTONS

Press the **LOCATION BUTTONS** to hear different phrases in different modes.



8. MELODY BUTTON

Press the **MELODY BUTTON** to hear melodies.



9. SING-ALONG SONG BUTTON

Press the **SING-ALONG SONG BUTTON** to hear sing-along songs.





Press the **VOLUME BUTTON** to adjust the volume.




15. FRONT STEERING LOCK

When the **FRONT STEERING LOCK** is in the unlocked position the handlebars will be able to move left and right. When the **FRONT STEERING LOCK** is in the locked position the handlebars will not be able to move left and right.



16. SWIVEL WHEELS

When the back wheel locks are in the  position, the back wheels can turn 360°. When the back wheel locks are in the  position, the back wheels will only go straight.



17. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, **4-in-1 Stroll & Grow Tek Trike™** will automatically turn off after several minutes of inactivity. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **ON/OFF BUTTON**.

The unit will also automatically turn off when the batteries are very low.
