

Four pop-up animal shapes fit in the trailer and bob up and down as kids push or pull the tractor. Go hog wild for learning about shapes, colors, numbers and animals!



#### **Unlock the Packaging Lock**



- Rotate the packaging lock counterclockwise 90 degrees.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging lock.

## **GETTING STARTED**

### **Battery Removal and Installation**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the tractor. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (LR03/AM-4) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

#### **BATTERY NOTICE**

- · Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.



#### MISE EN GARDE

- Utiliser des piles alcalines neuves pour des performances maximales.
- Seules des piles du type recommandé doivent être utilisées.
- Ne pas mélanger différents types de piles ou d'accumulateurs, ne pas mélanger des piles ou des accumulateurs neufs avec des usagés.
- Ne pas utiliser des piles ou des accumulateurs endommagés.
- Mettre en place les piles ou les accumulateurs en respectant les polarités + et -.
- Ne pas mettre les bornes d'une pile ou d'un accumulateur en courtcircuit (en reliant directement le + et le -).
- Enlever les piles ou les accumulateurs usagés du jouet.
- Retirer les piles ou les accumulateurs en cas de nonutilisation prolongée.
- · Ne les jeter ni au feu ni dans la nature.
- Ne pas tenter de recharger des piles non rechargeables.
- Enlever les accumulateurs du jouet pour les recharger.
- Les accumulateurs ne doivent être chargés que sous la surveillanced'un adulte.

## **PRODUCT FEATURES**

#### 1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the Low volume ϑ or the High volume ϑ position. You will hear a song, phrase and sound. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the Off • position.



#### 2. Pull Cord

To convert the unit from a push toy to a pull toy, remove the optional **Pull Cord** from under the tractor. For your child's safety, please store the **Pull Cord** in the battery compartment until your child is walking. (The **Pull Cord** is the recommended 9.64 inches in length. However, adult supervision is recommended).

#### 3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Sort & Wiggle Tractor™** will automatically shut off after approximately 70 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button or inserting an **Animal**.

#### NOTE

If the unit powers down or the light fades out during playing, please install a new set of batteries.

## **ACTIVITIES**

#### 1. Farmer Button

Press the **Farmer Button** to hear fun phrases, playful songs and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



#### 2. Shape Slots

Insert the shape sorting **Animals** into the **Shape Slots** or press the **Shape Buttons** in the **Shape Slots** to learn about animals, numbers and shapes. When a melody is playing, insert the animals into the **Shape Slots** or press the **Shape Buttons** to hear the animals sing with the melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



#### 3. Wheel Sensor

Push or pull the **Tractor** to hear playful sounds and tunes. When there are animals in the **Shapes Slots**, push the **Tractor** to hear animal sounds. When a melody is playing, push the **Tractor** to add fun sounds on the top of the melody. The light will flash with the sounds.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
