Unlock the packaging locks:



- Rotate the packaging lock counterclockwise 90 degrees.
- Pull out and discard the packaging lock.

GETTING STARTEDBATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.



- Install one new AA (LR6/AM-3) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of a new, alkaline battery is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit ON, slide the On/Off/
Volume Control Switch to the Low
Volume (■))) or the High Volume
(■))) position. You will hear a phrase
and a song. To turn the unit OFF, slide
the On/Off/Volume Control Switch to
the OFF (●) position.



2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Spin & Go Helicopter™** will automatically power down after approximately 45 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE: If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, we recommend changing the battery.

ACTIVITIES

1. Spinning Propeller

Press the **Spinning Propeller** to see the helicopter move forward. You will hear a variety of playful phrases, helicopter sounds and music.



2. Number Button

Press the **Number Button** to learn about numbers from one to three, hear the button color and animal introduced, and hear songs and short tunes.



3. Letter Button

Press the **Letter Button** to learn about beginning letters, hear the button color introduced, and hear fun phrases, songs and short tunes.



4. Wheel Sensor

Push the helicopter to hear a variety of playful phrases, helicopter sounds and music. When a melody or song is playing, push the helicopter to hear sounds play over the music.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
- 4. Turn the unit back **ON**. The unit will now be ready to play again.
