



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the Activity Panel. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 3 new 'AA' (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)



4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **VTech[®] Grow-Along Music Center[™]**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

- Insert the left foot and the right foot into the slots on the bottom of the support base. You will hear the feet click into place when inserted correctly.
- Insert the height adjustable support post into the recessed slot on the top of the support base.

- Turn the support base over and insert the three screws into the underside of the base. Use a screwdriver to secure the screws.
- 4. Insert the handle into the two holes on the front of the activity panel until you hear the handle click into place.









- Insert the electronic panel into the top of the height adjustable support post. The electronic panel will lock into position when inserted correctly.
- Press the buttons on both side of the height adjustable support post to adjust the height.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

To turn the unit ON, slide the ON/ OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the LOW VOLUME (◀))) or HIGH VOLUME (◀))) position. To turn the unit OFF, slide the ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the OFF (●) position.

2. MODE SELECTOR SWITCH

Slide the MODE SELECTOR SWITCH to the LEARNING MODE ((2000)), or MUSIC MODE (2000)), or Statement of the second second









3. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech[®] Grow-Along Music Center[™]** will automatically power-down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

ACTIVITIES

- 1. Slide the **on/off/volume control switch** to turn the unit on. You will hear a welcoming phrase, playful sounds, short tunes and a sung song, depending on the selected mode. The lights will flash with the sound.
- Press the 5 light-up piano keys to learn about colors and animals and hear fun sing-along songs in the Learning Mode. In the Music Mode, you will hear individual piano notes and short tunes. The lights will flash with the sounds.
- 3. Press the **3 instrument buttons** to learn about instruments and instrument sounds in the Learning Mode and hear a variety of short tunes and melodies in the Music Mode. The lights will flash with the sounds.
- 4. Turn the voice effect selector to change the style of your voice when singing into the microphone. Choose from regular voice, robot voice, high pitched voice and low pitched voice. The lights will flash with the sounds.

5. Sing into the **microphone** to hear your voice amplified. When you are using the microphone you will hear fun sounds to encourage you to keep using the microphone. The lights will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
