## Unlock the packaging locks:





- 1 Turn the packaging locks 90 degrees counterclockwise several times.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.


## **GETTING STARTED**

## **Battery Removal and Installation**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the airplane, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.

### IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

#### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:**

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## **PRODUCT FEATURES**

#### 1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Selector** to the Low volume **)**or the High volume **)**) position. You will hear sounds, phrases and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the **Off** ● position.



#### 2. Pull Cord

To convert the **Soar & Discover Airplane**<sup>™</sup> from a push toy to a pull toy, remove the pull cord from the battery compartment and thread it through the eyelet on the bottom of the airplane. For your child's safety we suggest you store the pull cord in the compartment until your child is walking and to supervise your child when playing with the pull cord.

#### 3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Soar & Discover Airplane™** will automatically power down after approximately 40 seconds without input. The airplane can be turned on again by pressing any button.

#### NOTE

If the unit powers down while playing or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

## **ACTIVITIES**

## 1. Learning Buttons

Press the **Learning Buttons** to learn about letters, numbers, parts of the airplane, and hear short tune and sounds. The light will flash with the sound.



#### 2. Bear Button

Press the **Bear** to see the propeller spin and hear cute sounds and phrases. The light will flash with the sound.



## 3. Light-Up Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to hear melodies and songs. The light will flash with the sound.



#### 4. Pull-Along Play

Pull the airplane to hear fun sounds and phrases to encourage play. The light will flash with the sound. For your child's safety, we recommend that you supervise your child while playing with the pull cord.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
