

## **Unlock the Packaging Locks**



- Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees counterclockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks and discard.



# GETTING STARTED

## **Battery Removal and Installation**

- Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- 2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 2 new AAA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH

rechargeable batteries are recommended.)



5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

# WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.

- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

#### RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## **IMPORTANT: INFORMATIONS CONCERNANT LES PILES**

- Mettre en place les piles ou les accumulateurs en respectant les polarités + et -.
- Ne pas mélanger des piles ou des accumulateurs neufs avec des usagés.
- Ne pas mélanger différents types de piles : alcalines, zinc-carbone et rechargeables.
- Seules des piles du type recommandé doivent être utilisées.
- Ne pas mettre les bornes d'une pile ou d'un accumulateur en courtcircuit (en reliant directement le + et le -).
- Retirer les piles ou les accumulateurs en cas de non-utilisation prolongée.
- Enlever les piles ou les accumulateurs usagés du jouet.
- Ne les jeter ni au feu ni dans la nature.

### PILES RECHARGEABLES

- Enlever, lorsque c'est possible, les accumulateurs du jouet pour les recharger.
- Les accumulateurs ne doivent être chargés que sous la surveillance d'un adulte.
- Ne pas tenter de recharger des piles non rechargeables.

# PRODUCT FEATURES

#### On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** ♠) position.You will hear a song, phrase, short tune and playful sounds. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** ● position.



#### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Learning Lights Sudsy Soap™** will automatically shut off after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

#### NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

# **ACTIVITIES**

## Pump Button

Press the **Pump Button** to hear fun sing along songs, short tunes, phrases and sounds. The music note light projector will glow and flash with the sounds.



#### 2. Music Button

Press the light-up **Music Button** to hear fun sing along songs and melodies. When a melody is playing, press the **Pump Button** to hear fun sounds play over the top of the melody. The light will flash with the sounds.



#### 3. Bubble Button

Press the **Bubble Button** to learn about colors and hear fun sounds and short tunes. The **Music Button** will flash with the sounds.



#### 4 Number Button

Press the **Number Button** to learn about numbers and counting, hear fun sounds and short tunes. The **Music Button** will flash with the sounds.



#### 5. Elephant Button

Press the **Elephant Button** to hear fun phrases, sounds and short tunes. The **Music Button** will flash with the sounds.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.
