

## **BATTERY INSTALLATION**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- 3. Install 2 new 'AAA' batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure the battery cover.



### **BATTERY NOTICE**

- Install batteries correctly observing the polarity (+, -) signs to avoid leakage.
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- · Do not use batteries of different types.
- Remove batteries from the equipment when the unit will not be used for an extended period of time.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- · Do not attempt to recharge ordinary batteries.


- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

# PRODUCT FEATURES

# 1. OFF/LOW/HIGH VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

To turn the unit on, slide the off/low/high volume control switch to the right. To turn the unit off, slide the switch back to the off (•) position.




### 2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Roll 'n Learn Caterpillar™ will automatically power-down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

# **ACTIVITIES**

 Slide the off/low/high volume control switch to the low volume or high volume position. You will hear "Let's roll" followed by a giggle sound effect, then a song will play. The light will flash with the song.



 Press a shaped button to hear the letter identified followed by a random melody. The light will flash with the melody. Press the same shaped button again to hear a phrase followed by a giggle sound effect. The light will flash with the sound.



Roll the caterpillar to activate the motion sensor to hear "Let's roll" followed by a song. The light will flash with the sound.

4. If there is no input for around 10 seconds, a random phrase will be heard. If there is no input for around 30 seconds, the unit will go into sleep mode.

- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
