



GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the electronic module. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove the old batteries by pulling up on one side of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries
- Do not use damaged batteries
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit On, slide the On/Off/
Volume Selector to the Low (1) or
High (1) volume position. You will
hear a playful phrase and a song. To
turn the unit Off, slide the On/Off/
Volume Selector to the Off ● position.



2. Mode Switch

Slide the Mode Switch to Playtime Mode or Sleepytime Mode or Sleepytime Mode or Sleepytime Mode or Sleepytime Mode. The light flashes in different colors in Playtime Mode and it slowly changes colors in Sleepytime Mode.

3. Eight Fabric Legs With Eight Shape Buttons

Eight colorful legs include eight musical **Shape Buttons** that teach musical notes, colors and shapes and play eight songs.



4. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Snug-a-Bug Musical Critter**™ will automatically power down after approximately 55 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light-Up Tummy Button

Press the Light-Up Tummy Button to learn numbers, playful songs and melodies in Playtime Mode. Hear soothing songs and Iullabies in Sleepytime Mode. Press and hold the music button in Sleepytime Mode to activate approximately five minutes of Iullabies. The light will flash in different colors in Playtime Mode and the light will slowly change colors in Sleepytime Mode.



2. Shape Buttons

Press the **Shape Buttons** to learn colors, shapes, music notes and short tunes in **Playtime Mode**. When a melody is playing and the shape buttons are pressed, the melody will play note by note. Simply stop pressing the buttons to resume normal play. The light will flash in different colors. In **Sleepytime Mode** you will hear cute sounds and a soothing melody. The light will slowly change colors.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- 5. The unit is surface washable. Remove the electronic module before wiping down the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries
- 4. Turn the unit back On. The unit should now be ready to use again
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries


