

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the Corkscrew Tumbler is turned Off.
- 2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a coin or screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.

- Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AA (AM-3/ LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).



5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.


1. Corkscrew Tumbler

When a marble passes through the **Corkscrew Tumbler**, lights will flash and the unit will play sound effects.




2. Corkscrew Tumbler Button

Press this button to change the music.



3. Off/Sound Switch

Slide the switch to the right ((J)) to turn on both music and sound effects. Slide the switch to the middle position J_{0} to play only sound effects. Slide the switch to the left \bullet to turn the unit off.



4. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Marble Rush**[™] **Corkscrew Rush Set**[™] will automatically turn off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by sliding the **Off/Sound Switch** to the Sound position. The unit will also automatically turn off when the batteries are very low. If the unit powers down while playing, install a new set of batteries.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be used for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces or expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
