- Blank card
- Scraps of scrapbook paper
- Glue
- Paint brush
- Pencil
- Paper clips
- Scissors

- 1** Start with a blank card and scraps of scrapbook paper. Cut the scrapbook papers into strips of different widths.
- 2** Paint glue on the front of the card and then set the strips down, carefully lining them up.
- 3** Let the card dry.
- 4** Draw an egg-shaped template to fit the size of your card.
- 5** Place clips on the side of the card where you will not cut. The clips ensure you don't cut the folded edge of the card.
- 6** Cut around the unclipped area of the egg shape.
